The Home Office imposes varying fees depending on the category of application such as visa entry clearance, leave to remain, settlement, or naturalisation.

- The applicable fee will depend on the immigration route and the applicant's individual circumstances.
- Most applications incur a standard fee for the principal applicant, with additional charges for any dependants.
- Certain routes also require payment of the Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS), which grants access to NHS services during the period of leave.
- It is important to note that Home Office fees are non-refundable, irrespective of the outcome of the application.

Fee Structure

- Home Office fees are subject to periodic revision.
- We recommend consulting the official UK Government fee schedule or contacting our office for the most current information.
- Our advisers will confirm the applicable fee at the time of instruction and prior to submission.

Consultation

Service	Fee	Description
Initial Consultation	£0	30 minutes in-person, phone, or video meeting to assess eligibility and provide initial advice. This will be a confidential initial consultation to assess your immigration or legal matter, clarify your options, and outline next steps.

Work Visa

Service	Fee	Description
Skilled Worker visa	£1,200	A Skilled Worker visa allows you to come to or stay in the UK to do an eligible job with an approved employer.
Senior or Specialist Worker visa	£900	A Senior or Specialist Worker visa allows you to come to or stay in the UK to do an eligible job at your employer's UK branch.
Overseas Domestic Worker visa	£900	Allows overseas household staff (e.g. cleaners, nannies, carers) to visit the UK with their employer if employed for at least one year and meeting eligibility criteria.
Graduate Trainee visa	£900	Enables overseas employees on structured training programmes to work in their employer's UK branch in a managerial or specialist role.

Secondment Worker visa	£900	For overseas employees transferred to the UK to work for a different organisation under a high-value contract between their employer and the UK entity.
Service Supplier visa	£900	For overseas employees or self-employed professionals contracted to deliver services to a UK company under an international trade agreement.
UK Expansion Worker visa	£900	For senior managers or specialist employees sent to establish a UK branch of an overseas business that has not yet begun trading locally.
Representative of an Overseas Business visa	£900	For employees of overseas newspapers, news agencies, or broadcasters assigned to the UK on a long-term posting.
Seasonal Worker visa	£800	Allows overseas applicants to work temporarily in UK horticulture (up to 6 months) or poultry (2 Oct–31 Dec), subject to sponsorship and eligibility.
Government Authorised Exchange visa	£800	For overseas applicants undertaking short-term training, research, fellowships, or language programmes in the UK under an approved sponsored exchange scheme.
Creative Worker visa	£800	For overseas creatives such as actors, dancers, musicians, or crew members offered short-term work in the UK's creative industries, subject to sponsorship and eligibility.
Religious Worker visa	£800	For overseas applicants undertaking non-pastoral religious duties or joining a religious order in the UK, subject to sponsorship and eligibility.
Charity Worker visa	£800	For overseas applicants undertaking unpaid voluntary work with a UK-registered charity, subject to sponsorship and eligibility.
International Agreement visa	£800	For overseas nationals contracted to work in the UK under international law, including roles with foreign governments, recognised organisations, or diplomatic households.
Innovator Founder visa	£1,000	For entrepreneurs endorsed to establish and run a genuinely innovative UK business that's distinct from anything currently on the market.
Global Talent visa	£1,000	A UK immigration route for leaders or emerging talents in academia, research, arts, or digital technology, endorsed by recognised bodies.
International Sportsperson visa	£800	For elite athletes and qualified coaches endorsed by their sport's governing body to contribute to high-level sporting development in the UK.

Minister of Religion visa (T2)	£800	For overseas applicants offered roles within UK faith communities, such as ministers, missionaries, or religious order members, subject to sponsorship and eligibility.
Scale-up Worker visa	£800	For skilled overseas professionals joining fast-growing UK businesses in eligible roles, where the employer meets sponsorship and scale-up criteria.
Frontier Worker permit	£800	For EU, EEA or Swiss nationals who live outside the UK but began working here by 31 December 2020 and continue to work in the UK at least annually; not available to British citizens.
Get an exempt vignette	£800	Optional entry clearance for individuals exempt from UK immigration control, helping to avoid delays at the border when working or entering the UK.

Family Visa

Service	Fee	Description
Spouse visa	£1,000	For partners of British citizens or settled persons seeking to join or remain with their spouse in the UK, subject to meeting financial and accommodation requirements.
Unmarried Partner visa	£1,000	For long-term partners (at least 2 years cohabitation) of British citizens or settled persons who are not married or in a civil partnership.
Fiancé(e) or Proposed Civil Partner visa	£1,000	For individuals coming to the UK to marry or register a civil partnership within 6 months of arrival, after which they can switch to a spouse visa.
Child visa	£850	For children under 18 joining a parent who is a British citizen, settled person, or has refugee/humanitarian protection status in the UK.
Adult Dependent Relative visa	£1,200	For elderly or disabled parents, grandparents, or other adult relatives who require long-term personal care and cannot access adequate care in their home country.
Parent visa	£850	For parents of children who are British citizens or have lived in the UK for 7+ years, subject to meeting strict eligibility and financial requirements.

Student visa (Tier 4)	£800	For individuals aged 16+ coming to the UK to study at a licensed student sponsor (university, college, or school), subject to meeting course, financial, and English language requirements.

Business Visitor visa	£550	For overseas professionals visiting the UK for up to 6 months to attend meetings, negotiate contracts, deliver internal training, or undertake permitted activities under a business arrangement; selling goods, working, or studying is not allowed.
Student Visitor visa	£550	For short-term study in the UK (up to 6 months), including English language courses, research, electives, exams, and clinical attachments; no work or long-term study permitted.
Academic Visitor visa	£550	For short-term study in the UK (up to 6 months), including English language courses, research, electives, exams, and clinical attachments; no work or long-term study permitted.
Permitted Paid Engagement visa	£550	For recognised professionals invited to the UK for a pre-arranged, short-term paid event or engagement relevant to their expertise; must be completed within the first month of a visit of up to 6 months.

Medical Visitor visa	£550	For individuals seeking private treatment, NHS care under reciprocal arrangements, or organ donation assessment in the UK; permitted for up to 6 months with supporting documentation required.
Under-18 Visitor visa	£550	Minors may visit the UK for up to 6 months if they have suitable travel and accommodation plans, written parental consent (if travelling alone), sufficient funds, and no intention to work or claim public support.

Global Talent visa	£1,000	A UK immigration route for leaders or emerging talents in academia, research, arts, or digital technology, endorsed by recognised bodies.

EU Settlement Scheme

Service	Fee	Description
Joining EU/EEA Family Member	£1,000	For non-UK family members of EU, EEA or Swiss nationals whose relationship began by 31 December 2020, and whose relative was living in the UK by that date; the family member must be in the UK or travel there with you within 6 months. Applications must be made from outside the UK.
Joining a Person of Northern Ireland	£1,000	For eligible family members of a person born in Northern Ireland with British or dual British-Irish citizenship, living in the UK since before 31 December 2020, and holding (or eligible for) settled or pre-settled status. Applications must be made from outside the UK.
Retained Right of Residence	£1,000	For non-UK nationals who previously lived in the UK through an eligible family member but retain residence rights due to bereavement, separation, or domestic abuse; must apply from outside the UK.

Youth Mobility Visa

Service	Fee	Description
Youth Mobility Scheme visa	£650	Enables young adults from eligible countries to live, work, and travel in the UK for up to 2 years without sponsorship.

Commonwealth & Legacy Routes

Service	Fee	Description
British National (Overseas) visa	£850	If you're from Hong Kong and are a British national (overseas) you and your family members can apply for a British National (Overseas) visa.
UK Ancestry visa	£850	Permits Commonwealth citizens with a UK-born grandparent to live, work, and study in the UK for up to 5 years.
Windrush Scheme	£850	For individuals settled in the UK without formal proof, especially those who arrived from Commonwealth countries before 1973 or whose parents did; offers free documentation confirming the right to live and work in the UK, such as an eVisa or official letter.

Marriage Visitor Visa

Service	Fee	Description
Marriage Visitor visa	£800	For individuals aged 18+ who wish to marry or register a civil partnership in the UK without settling afterwards; not required for Irish citizens or those with (or awaiting) EU Settlement Scheme status.

Graduate Visa

Service	Fee	Description
Graduate visa	£400	UK Graduate visa allows eligible international graduates to stay for up to 2 years after completing their course. PhD graduates may stay for up to 3 years
